Overview:

This is the second seminar in the two year training program in engaged transformative community research. In advance of the seminar, participants will have been sent to read key documents which have been included in the digital binder. The seminar includes an intensive lectures on data gathering methods by the trainers. The focus is on qualitative methods, since quantitative methods require more intensive lectures and discussions than is possible in the seminar. The trainers include Drs. Each participant is required to make a presentation every day to the writing group and share their assignments for feedback. The third seminar will be in Fall 2017 and fourth in Winter 2018. In the course of the two years, the researchers will complete a research proposal, data gathering, data analysis, writing analysis, and presenting in a final public conference. Those who successfully complete their proposals will be funded for a pilot project to carry out the research under the mentorship of one of the trainers.
