- ❖ 69% of women in Morocco report that they do not have access to a health care provider while 82% of men report not having access to a health care provider. Health care is 23% more available in urban areas than in rural areas.¹ The majority of women lack access to a health care provider, 57% of women in urban areas and 81% of women in rural areas.¹
- ❖ The percent of the country's national GDP spent on health is 6.4%.²
- A woman's median age of first child is 25.4 years. The contraceptive prevalence rate is 67.4%. The fertility rate in Morocco increased from 2.4 in 2005 to 2.7 in 2012.
- ❖ In 2010 there were 100 deaths per 100,000 live births.² The maternal mortality per 100,000 births in 2013 was 120.³
- Female life expectancy at birth is 72.6 years.⁴
- Unwed mothers are likely to give birth under unsanitary and unhealthy conditions without proper healthcare.⁵
- 95% of lower class women give birth at home, compared to the 6% of upper class women who deliver at home.⁵
- Assistance in delivery has reduced the health risk for women. In 1992, 31% of births were delivered by medical professionals. This percentage increased to 63 in 2004.⁵
- ❖ The percentage of women who received prenatal care in 2011 was 77.1.³
- ❖ There are 11,000 women living with HIV in Morocco as of 2012.6
